GA-2023-91-RES-09

Subject: Improving the quality of supervision measures for data processing

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Vienna, Austria, from 28 November to 1 December 2023, at its 91st session:

RECOGNIZING the essential endowment of INTERPOL's notices and diffusions system to combating crime and bringing criminal offenders to justice,

RECALLING Resolution AG-2015-RES-09 (2015, Rwanda), which tasked the General Secretariat to consider specific proposals for possible procedural improvements with regard to INTERPOL's Rules on the Processing of Data (RPD),

REAFFIRMING respect to data protection principles, such as transparency, accountability and data quality that provide a basis of trust for member countries to exchange data via INTERPOL channels, as well as the Organization's working bodies responsible for data compliance with INTERPOL's requirements,

ACKNOWLEDGING a key role of the General Secretariat with regard to the supervision of data exchanged through the INTERPOL Information System and its enhanced responsibility in the publication of notices and diffusions circulation,

RECOGNIZING the equal rights and equality of all Members before INTERPOL's governing bodies and the General Secretariat,

ACKNOWLEDGING the efforts of all Members to contribute effectively to the prevention and suppression of ordinary law crimes,

HAVING EXAMINED Report GA-2023-91-REP-12 submitted by Belarus concerning amendments to INTERPOL Rules on the Processing of Data and the promotion of supervision measures for data processing,

TASKS the Committee on the Processing of Data to consider the proposals regarding the settlement of disputes, improving the quality of the assessment of INTERPOL notices and diffusions and supervision measures for data processing, submitted by Belarus, as set out in Report GA-2023-91-REP-12, and to report back to the General Assembly and the Executive Committee for further discussion and approval.
